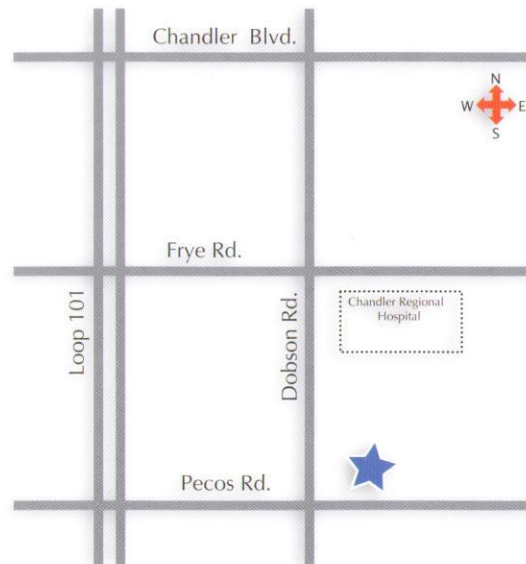

Our staff of medical providers have advanced training and experience in the diagnosis and treatment of all types of skin cancer as well as all other skin conditions.

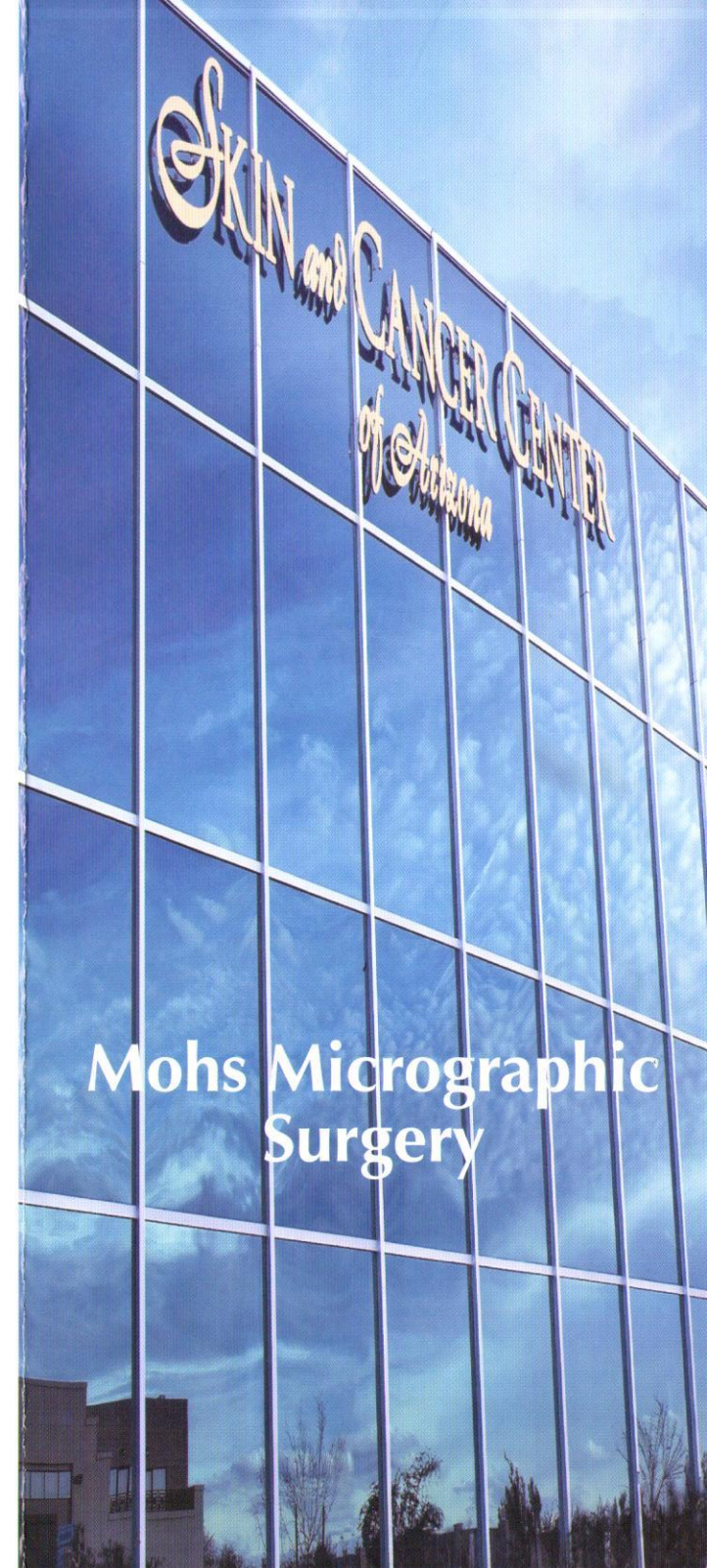
